How to build your profile

- There's no time like the present!
 - Don't wait until you've got years of experience under your belt before you start thinking about your profile
 - Profile building is something you can get started when you're in your first role
- Focus on the work and let the profile follow
 - As Shelina mentioned, profile building was never something she intentionally set out to work on until much later in her career
 - By focusing on the work itself, rather than how it can benefit your public profile, you're much more likely to have a greater impact and be considered an authority within your profession or sector

Becoming your own advocate

- Don't be afraid to talk about what you know
- Don't be embarrassed about things you've got wrong - learn from it and move on
- Make the time to reflect on what you have done and what you have achieved, and give yourself a pat on the back!
- Say what you want to say with confidence and conviction
- But also, if you don't have something to say about a certain subject, it's okay to hold your hands up and say so!
- You don't have to have all the answers
- The power of meetings - if you can't contribute the most, make sure you listen the most

The Importance of a Network

- Without meaningful relationships you won't get very far in life
- Throughout Shelina's life and career, she knows it was the support of her networks that got her through her most challenging times
- Much like profile building, it's never too early to start thinking about expanding your networks

How to Grow Your Network
